

Checking that Your Virus Scanner is Enabled.

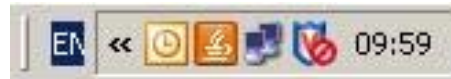
McAfee Viruscan is configured to run on all NUIM PCs running Windows to ensure protection against computer viruses. When McAfee is running properly, a blue shield with a red V on it is displayed in the system tray of your task bar (the grey bar that is normally located on the bottom of your computer screen)



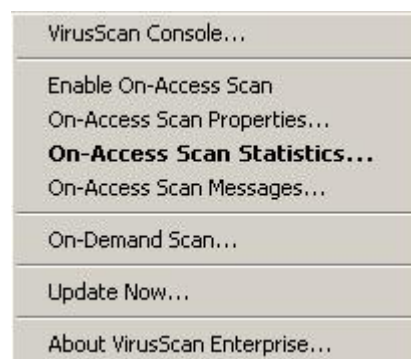
Your system tray may have minimised, hiding the McAfee Shield. Click these two chevrons to expand the system tray and check if the shield is displayed

McAfee Shield Enabled

It has come to our attention that some viruses are turning off the virus scan on infected machines so that the user is unaware of the virus infections. When McAfee is disabled the V shield has a red circle with a line through it.



If your McAfee shield has the disabled sign please right-click on it. You should get a menu similar to the following:



Try clicking on **Enable On-Access Scan**. This may re-enable the virus scanner, removing the disabled sign from the shield. However, if for any reason you are unable to do this please contact the Computer Centre Helpdesk at Extension 3388 for assistance.
